If users simply need to view reports created by others, you do not need to install the Crystal Reports software on their PCs.

Save time

cView can be installed as the default viewer of RPT files for users who wish to view Crystal Reports designed by others. cView includes all the Crystal Reports run time files to view a Crystal Report.

If your users are comfortable using "File/Open" in other programs they have all the instructions they need to use cView. They find the Crystal Report and process it live against the database.

Interactive Reports

If a report uses parameters, cView will prompt the user with the questions and allow them to select answers from picklists.

A viewed report can then be exported to other formats including PDF, Excel, Word, or even XML. The results can be printed, emailed or saved in a disk folder.
